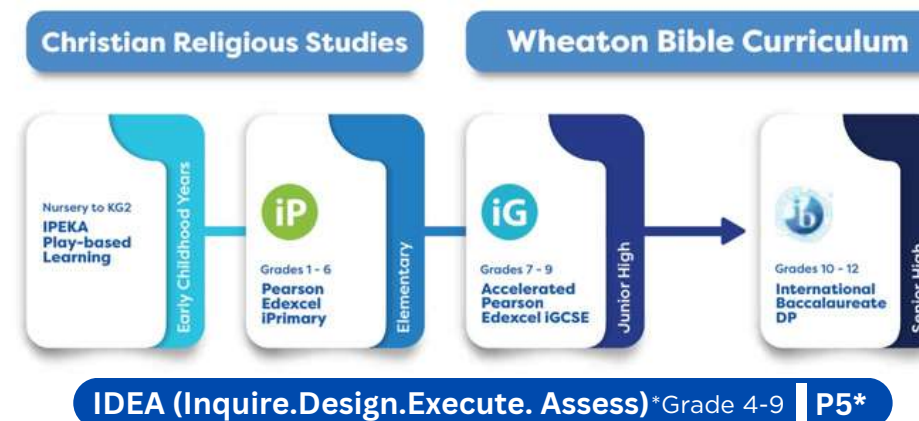


OUR CURRICULUM

KINDERGARTEN



At IICS, the Early Childhood Education Program embraces a purposeful play-based approach to stimulate comprehensive child development, rooted in Biblical values. Through collaborative play and daily Mandarin conversations, children develop essential 21st-century skills across spiritual, social, emotional, physical, cognitive, and linguistic domains.

ELEMENTARY

The Elementary Curriculum, based on Pearson Edexcel iPrimary Curriculum, integrates a Biblical perspective with a concept-based inquiry approach. This method immerses students in learning experiences that enhance their understanding across various subjects, culminating in the Pearson iPrimary Achievement Test at Grade 6.



JUNIOR HIGH



Junior High students enter the rigorous Pearson Edexcel iGCSE program preparing them for the world-class International Baccalaureate Diploma (IBDP). Teachers adopt a concept-based inquiry instructional approach, and students engage in co-curricular and extracurricular activities in real-world contexts. Learning is project-based and connects teaching, and service to local, regional, and global communities, culminating with presentations of students achievements.

SENIOR HIGH

The Senior High is an authorized IB World School offering the IBDP since May 2021. Students take Grade 10 - Pre-IB classes explicitly designed to prepare them for IBDP success. They begin their Diploma Programme studies during Grades 11-12 (DP1/DP2) when they tackle problem-based and experiential learning and use analytical skills to evaluate real-world situations for community involvement and global impact.
